Business and Non-Instructional Operations

Tuition Fees

The Board of Education will permit students from other school districts to attend local schools when they can be accommodated in existing classes. The student(s) or their sending district shall pay a tuition fee to be established annually by the Superintendent of Schools. The tuition fee may be adjusted as changes in costs indicate unless a multiple year agreement to provide educational facilities is entered into with another Board of Education.
