Farouk Rajab, Board Chairman called the special meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Members present were Heidi Simmons, Secretary, Dan Kelley, Sara Baker, Kevin Agnello, and Craig Esposito. Discussion and Motion Regarding Reduction In Force (RIF)

Mary Anne Butler, Superintendent explained the Reduction in Force (RIF) process, the reason for the change in wording to the agenda item, and the May 1st deadline. Farouk Rajab, Chairman noted there was a memo from the Superintendent to the Board of Education that addressed the non-renewals and the teachers' names. Dan Kelley had questions as to why this item was not on last week's meeting agenda. Dan Kelley asked are these the only six non-tenure staff that we have on duty, if they are classroom teachers, and how it affects the teaching and classroom sizes. Superintendent Butler explained that we do have other non-tenure teachers. Superintendent Butler explained the district looks at seniority and certification in the roles that they are in. The six are teachers and one school psychologist. She also reviewed the impact on the schools and classroom sizes. However, noted there is also an opportunity to recall some of these positions if the referendum passes, or if staffing changes.
