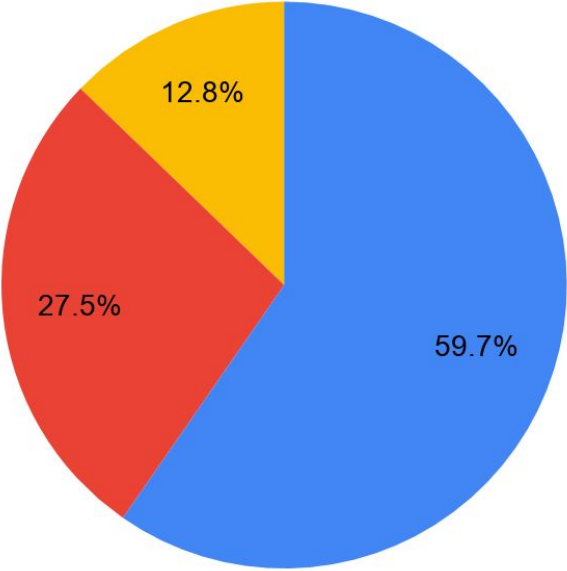
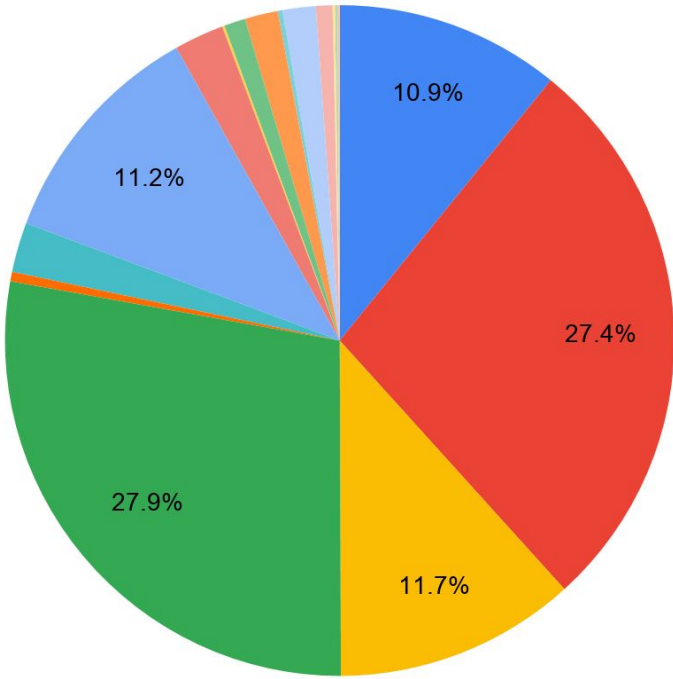

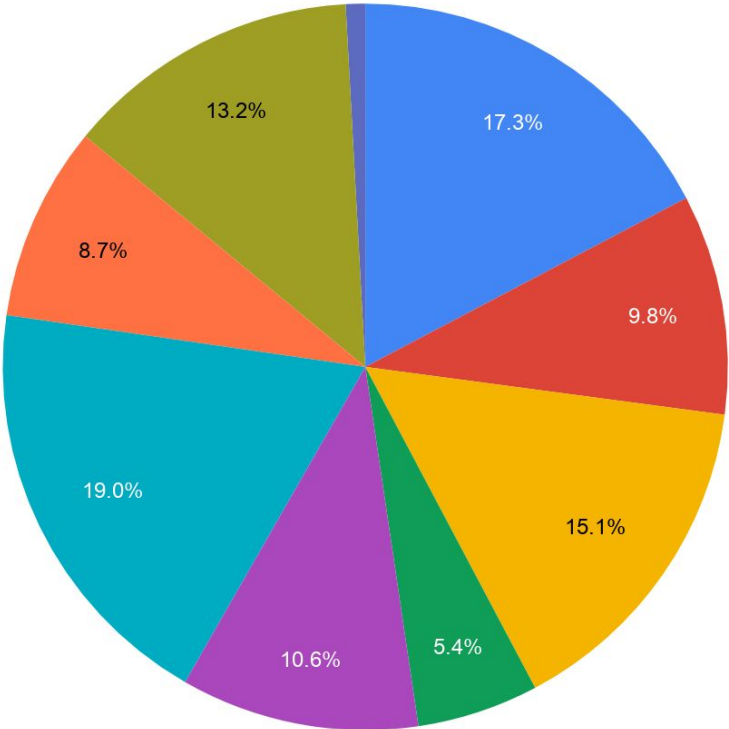
- Physically in the school building with safety measures applied.

In which grade bands will your child or children be enrolled/work in 2020-2021? (Check all that apply.)



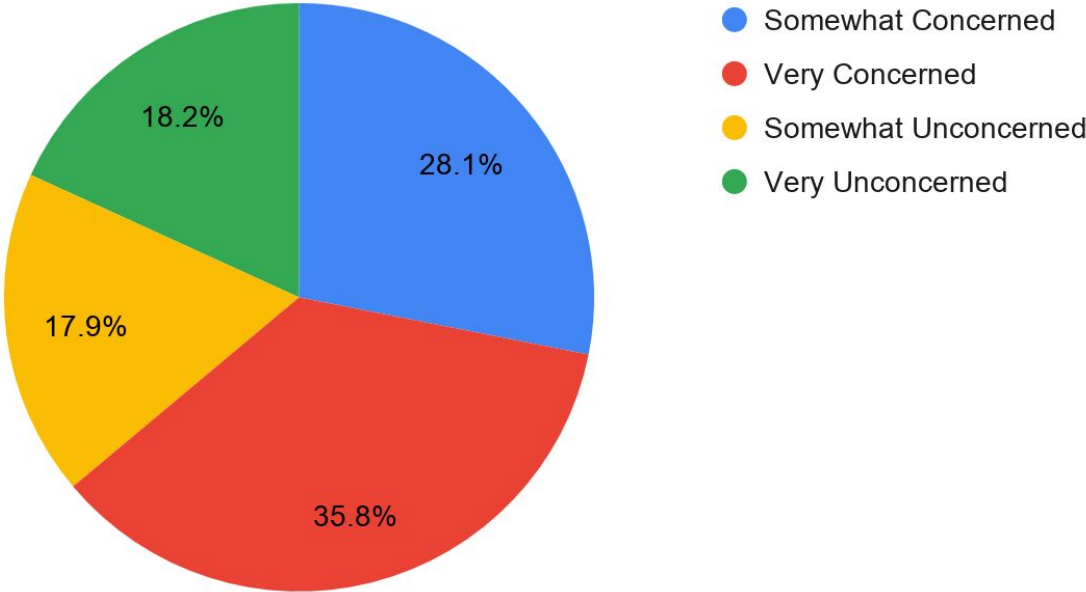

What, if anything, would make you more likely to allow your child or children attend school in-person? (Check all that apply.)

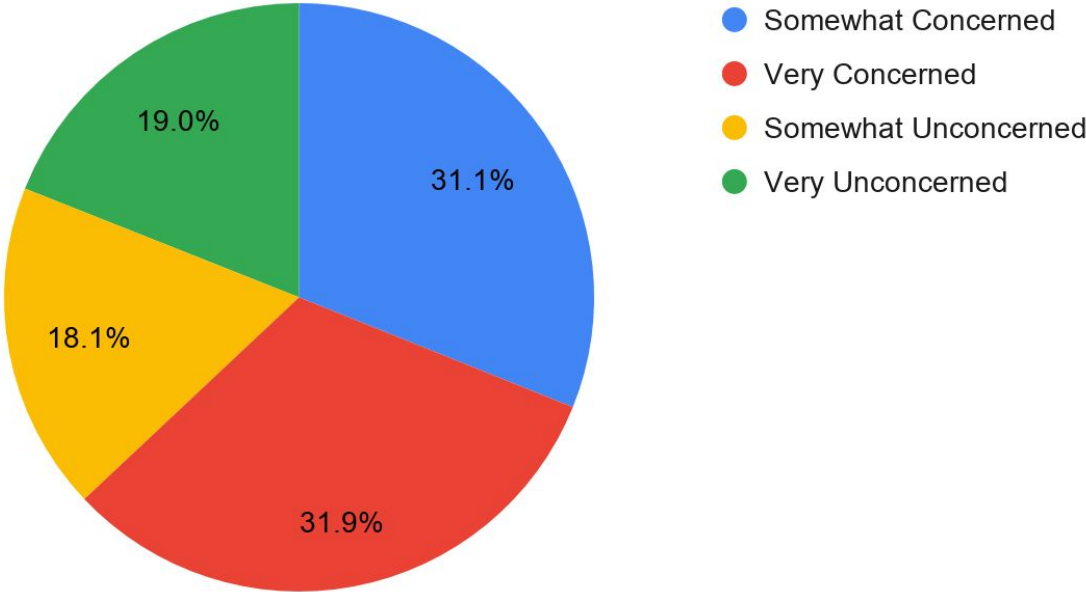


- 17.3% - The number of new infections of COVID-19 in Connecticut decreases.

- 2.3% - Nothing, I do not plan on a return to school in 2020-2021.

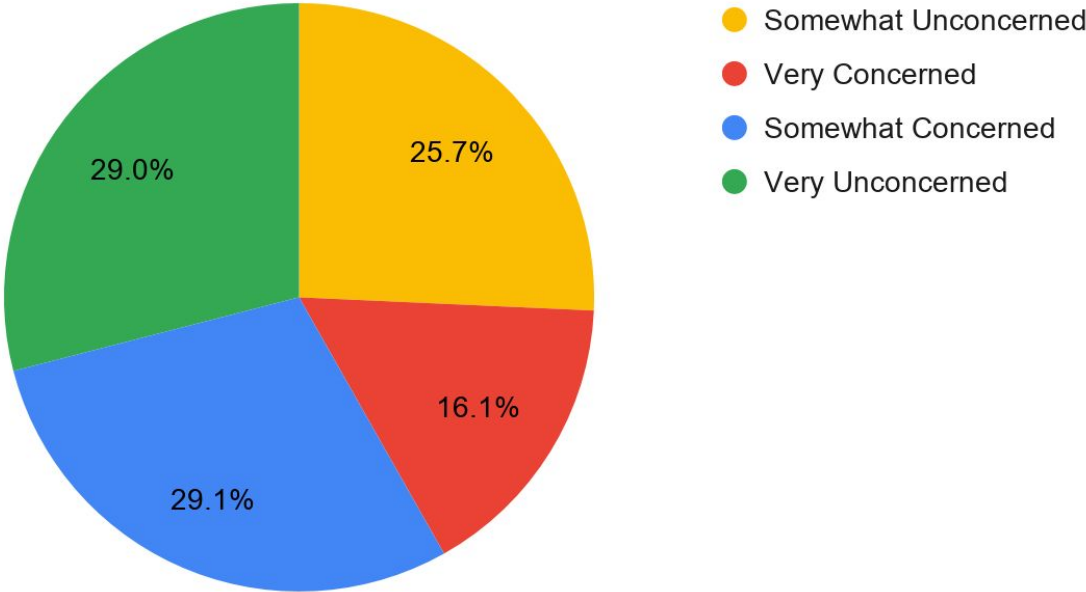
How concerned are you about online learning and communication between teachers, students, and parents? Percentages of 875 responses



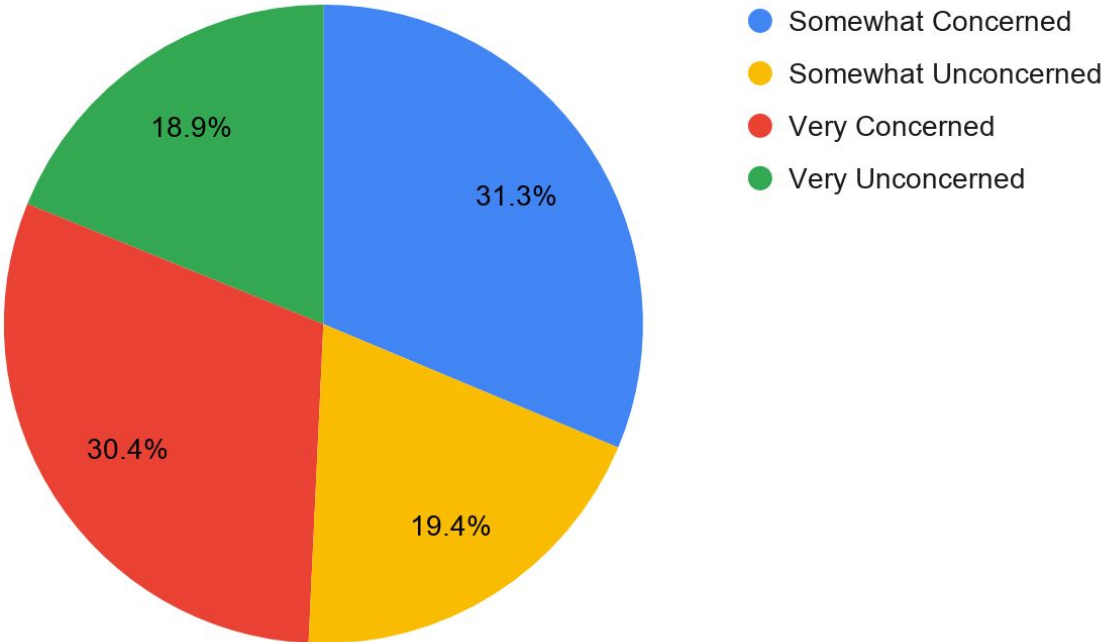
How concerned are you with students being held accountable to attend online classes? Percentages out of 875 responses



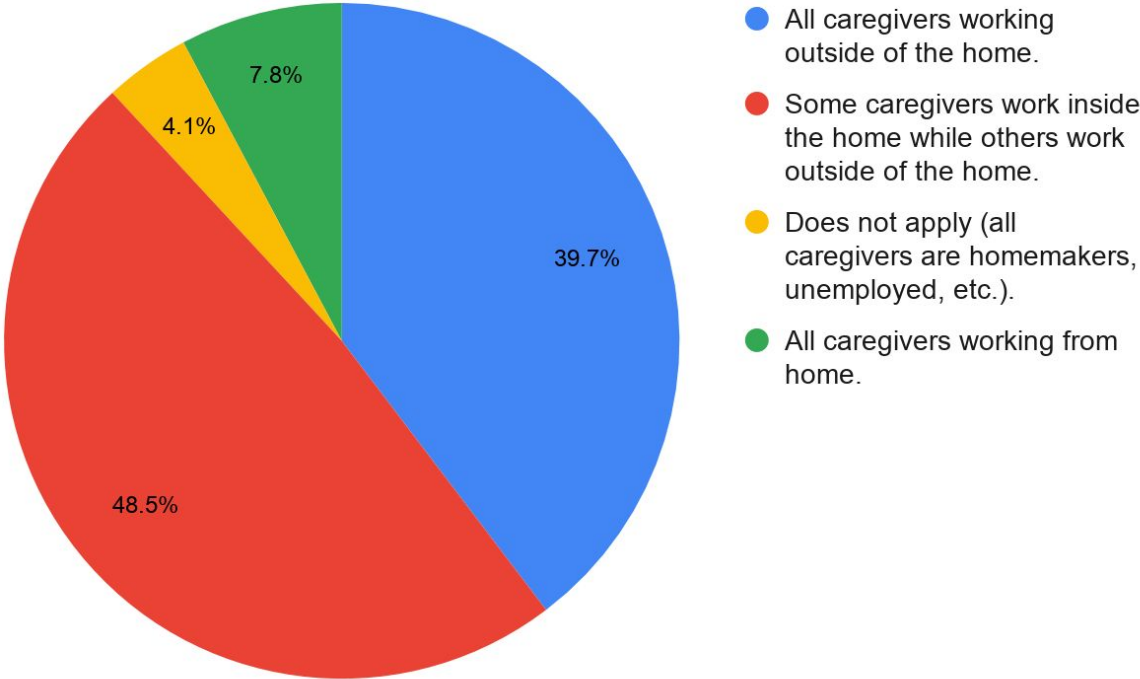
How concerned are you about online learning and lack of experience with specific computer programs? Percentages out of 875 responses
